Artists agree to release use of images of accepted works to TCA only as a permanent record of the exhibition and only for promotional use related to the exhibition and the art center.

Once accepted, artists may submit a high resolution image for consideration for use in print promotions including the exhibit postcard. Please email a jpeg file at least 300 dpi to exhibitions@tubacarts.org. Please include in the subject line of your email, "19 Exhibition Print". Please include your last name and first initial along with the title in the name of the file.
example: **SmithJ_Painting.jpg**.

Artwork:

Entry must be original, entirely the work of the artist, executed within the last 12 months, and cannot have been previously shown at TCA. Giclee reproductions are **not** permitted.

Art may not be removed from the exhibit prior to the close of the exhibition on Sunday, October 22, 2017.

Delivery/Shipping:

Artists are responsible for shipping to and from TCA. Unsold work will be shipped back to the artist after close of the exhibition. Artists must provide a PREPAID barcoded shipping label for the return of their artwork.

The 19 exhibition features artists along the I-19 arts corridor from Nogales to South Tucson. Artists must live for at least part of the year south of 29th Street (West of Kolb and East of Kenney Rd) in Tucson, the Pascua Yaqui Xavier and Tohono Oo'dham nations, City of South Tucson, Sahuarita, Green Valley, Amado, Tubac, Tumacacori-Carmen, Rio Rico, and Nogales.

Please note, artists from Davis-Monthan Air Force Base are eligible. This exhibition accepts 2D and 3D art objects, as well as video.

Fees:

Jurying will be done on the basis of digital images in jpg format. Up to 3 works may be entered for consideration. Nonrefundable entry fee is \$28 for the first image, \$3 each additional image. Payments are made at the end of the CaFE™ entry process either via credit card online or a check mailed to the art center.

The I-19 Project and the 19 exhibition:

The 19 Exhibition is a celebration of the vibrant and innovative arts corridor that extends from South Tucson to Nogales. As an extension of our annual Open Studio Tour, the 19 Exhibition is an example of some of the fine artists that live and work in the region. The extent of talent and ability will surprise and delight patrons, as the Center works to celebrate the arts in Southern Arizona.

Presentation:

All artwork must arrive in a condition ready to professionally display or hang. If framed, work must be suitably matted, (white, black or neutral colors preferred), simply framed and firmly wired. No saw tooth hangers. TCA reserves the right to disqualify any selected entry upon arrival that does not meet the above requirements or is deemed unsuitable for display.

Sales:

All work must be for sale. TCA will retain a 40% commission, Price work accordingly.
