Exhibit entry fees are based on a per linear/square foot. Artists may rent 2d wall space (linear ft) or 3d floor/pedestal space (square ft) to exhibit their work. 2d work is hung Salon Style.

Members: \$15 per linear ft. 2d, sqft. 3d.

Non Members: \$18 per linear ft. 2d, sqft. 3d.

JURY Process:

Jurying will be done on the basis of digital images in a jpg format only. Send an email to exhibitions@tubacarts.org with 2-4 samples of your work that you intend to exhibit. Please include your last name and first initial along with the title in the name of the file. **example:** SmithJ_PaintingTitle.jpg

Please include in the email with your images, the Title, Medium, Dimension and Price, along with your artist bio and statement.

Artists that have previously exhibited in "Summer Gallery" in the last 2 years can submit their application without jury and are automatically accepted if they meet the eligibility requirements. (See #2 under "Important Information" for eligibility.)

Call to Artists:

Summer Gallery is an exhibit of TCA member artists & Santa Cruz Valley artists showcasing a variety of art mediums from painting to jewelry, sculpture, photography and more. The exhibit is hung Salon style, floor to ceiling, and includes a community supported gala opening reception.

Tubac Center of the Arts is dedicated to the celebration and promotion of the arts through education, exhibitions, performances, and the collection and presentation of art that honors the artistic and historic heritage of Tubac and the Santa Cruz Valley.

Artwork:

Giclee reproductions are not permitted. Exhibited work must be original, entirely the work of the artist, executed within the last 24 months.

Note - any work exhibited in Summer Gallery is NOT eligible for inclusion in TCA exhibits for the following two years.

Delivery/Hanging:

TCA will supervise hanging/installation. Artists are responsible for delivery and hanging of artwork in an appropriate fashion during specified installation times. Unsold work must be picked up after close of the exhibition.

Please provide your own nails, hanging hardware and hammers. TCA will provide a limited number of pedestals for 3d work, levels, measuring tapes, hammers and ladders.

May 1 - July 1, 2013

Notifications of acceptance will be provided on a rolling basis as applications are received. Space is limited. Wall space will be ASSIGNED by TCA staff upon entry acceptance. First come, first served.

Pick up of unsold work: September 6-9, 2013

Important Information -

Please read thoroughly!

1. A limited number of artists may rent space in the gallery at TCA during the Summer Gallery exhibit.
2. Eligibility: Artists must either be a MEMBER in good standing with TCA OR must reside in Santa Cruz Co., AZ.
3. Artists will be chosen by jury review of work samples. First come, first served.
4. Artists who participate in "Summer Gallery" will be required to volunteer for gallery duty during the exhibit for at least 2 shifts, 10am - 12:30pm or 12:30pm - 4:30pm as gallery attendant.
5. TCA will be open for summer hours Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays ONLY during this exhibition.
6. Artists are expected to contribute an appetizer to the gala reception. TCA will provide wine & non-alcoholic beverages and supplies for the reception.
7. Participants are encouraged to promote and market the exhibit and their work individually, including ordering postcards and promoting to their own mailing lists.
8. Participants are encouraged to schedule demos and other special events during the duration of the exhibit to enhance publicity and visitor attendance.
Work exhibited during "Summer Gallery" will not be accepted in future TCA exhibits.
9. Artists should provide an excel spreadsheet of inventory to be exhibited including title, medium, dimension and price no later than July 1, 2013.

Sales:

All work must be for sale. TCA will retain a 40% commission. Price work accordingly.

Images:

Artists agree to release use of images of accepted works to TCA as a permanent record of the exhibition and for promotional use relating to the exhibition and the art center.

Agreement:

By signing below, artist agrees to all the terms and conditions noted in this prospectus and commits to exhibit in the Summer Gallery, hang and remove their work as scheduled, and volunteer as a gallery host during the exhibit. Artists agree to provide an excel spreadsheet of the inventory they exhibit prior to the scheduled installation date. Artists understand that work exhibited in the Summer Gallery 2013 is not eligible for inclusion in future TCA exhibitions for 2 years.
